Alice Joanne Bowman passed away peacefully at home on Wednesday, August 27, 2025, at the age of 93. She was born in Valley Township, Chester County, on April 24, 1932, to Charles Edmund Young and Lila Olivia Young, née Rupp.

Her early years were spent in Ephrata, graduating from Ephrata High School in 1950, then attending Penn State University, followed by an internship at Reading Hospital and employment at the Atlee medical offices in Lancaster.

In 1954, she married her high school sweetheart, Dr. John H. Bowman. They lived in Philadelphia, Fort Defiance, Arizona, and Rochester, Minnesota, before settling in Lancaster.

Joanne spent much of her free time at home with her family and found extra time for bridge, tennis, bowling, and fly fishing. She volunteered with Meals on Wheels for 35 years. She enjoyed the outdoors at the couple's cabin in Jackson Township, Huntingdon County. Summers may have included a family trip to Long Beach Island, New Jersey, or Fenwick Island, Delaware.

Joanne is survived by her husband John of over 70 years, children, John (Barb), Lisa, and Charles (Gina); grandchildren: Skylar (Kaitlyn), Pierce, and Bryce; and great-grandchildren, Aiden and Ryder.

Joanne was a long-term survivor of bilateral breast cancer with metastatic disease, treated successfully by her cancer physicians; the family is very thankful.

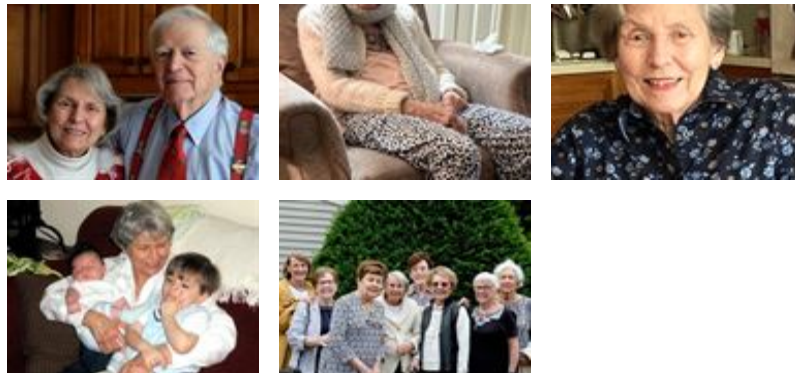
