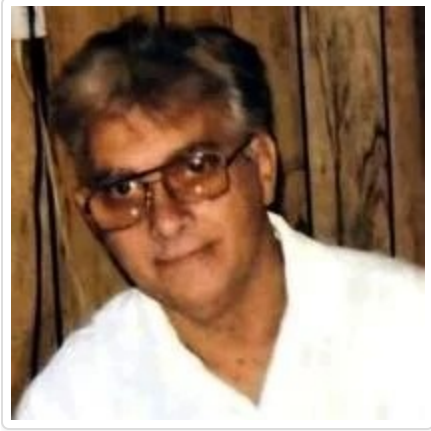




Barry L. Floyd
