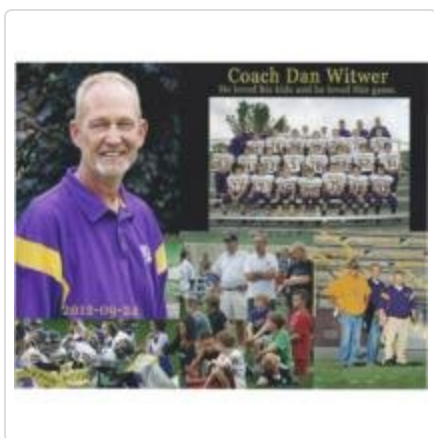




Daniel Ben Witwer
