David L. “Wally” Lorah, 67, of Landisville, died peacefully in his home surrounded by his family on Monday, February 26, 2024, after a long-fought battle with cancer. Born in Ephrata PA, he was the son of Howard S. Lorah and the late Barbara Schall. Dave married his wife, Beth, in 1978 and they raised three children together over the span of their 45-year marriage.

Dave attended J.P. McCaskey High School before completing the welding program at Willow Street Vo Tech. A particular point of pride, he later completed his GED at the age of 40. Early in his career, Dave worked as a welder for Posey Ironworks before becoming a machine operator at the Kellogg Company where he worked for 34 years until his retirement in 2020.

Nicknamed “Wally” after his infectious laugh reminiscent of the classic cartoon alligator, Dave found joy in a variety of hobbies, including playing for a church softball league as a dedicated slugger in the early 80s. He was also an avid bowler, participating in a variety of leagues at both Rocky Springs and Leisure Lanes, most notably representing Midway Hotel. His love for golf extended beyond the greens, creating lasting memories as he shared the fairways with his son and brothers-in-law.

Dave’s love for family beach vacations at Rehoboth Beach and Sea Isle City was built upon a life-long tradition of family togetherness. He was the

unwavering captain of the annual sun-soaked adventures, leading the charge for boardwalk games, mini golf, and seafood feasts.

He is survived by his wife, Beth, children, Amy (Cory Trimble), Bryan (Stephanie Bray), and Kelly, as well as his grandchildren, Landon, Marci, and Mia. He is also survived by 2 brothers, 2 stepbrothers, and a stepsister. He was preceded in death by his stepmother, Patricia Lorah and an older stepbrother.

A Memorial Gathering will be held at The Groff's Family Funeral Home, 528 W. Orange Street, Lancaster, PA on Monday, March 4, 2024, from 6:30-8:00 p.m. Interment at Greenwood Cemetery will be private at the discretion of the family.
