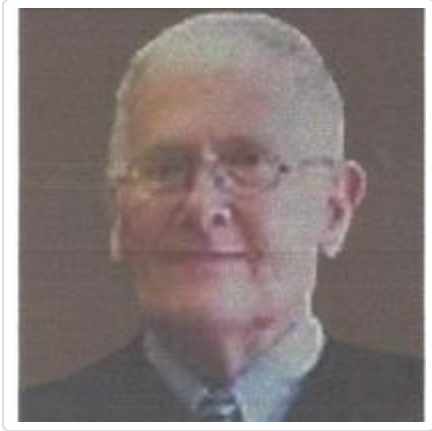




Glenn D. Keys

Glenn D. Keys, 82, of Lancaster died on Tuesday June 7, 2016 at Lancaster General Hospital. Born in Ephrata, PA, he was the son of the late Clifford E. and Minnie Dunkelberger Keys and the husband of Peggy Dodd Keys, with whom he celebrated 62 years of marriage.

Glenn received his BS and Masters Degrees from Peabody/Vanderbilt University in Nashville, Tennessee. He pursued additional graduate studies at Boston University.

He was a professor at Pasadena College, Pasadena, CA (now known as Point Loma Nazarene University, San Diego, CA), where a new Biology Laboratory was recently named in his honor. He also taught for many years at Eastern Nazarene College in Quincy, MA, where he was Chairman of the Biology Department, and in 2004 was recognized with an honorary Doctorate of Science. In retirement he returned to the Lancaster area, where he pursued his interests of travel, cycling, tennis, growing orchids and was a substitute teacher in local schools.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by three daughters, Brenda Keys, Oakland, CA, Sherry Keys, wife of David Parker, Falls Church, VA, Kathy Keys-Ludwig, wife of Matthew Keys-Ludwig, Lancaster, PA, and a son, Jerry Keys, husband of Deborah Aichele Keys, Lancaster, PA; as well as a brother,

Clifford Keys, and seven grandchildren, Anika, Ryan, Andy, Julianne, Sam, Alex and Anika, and one great grandson, Elliott Glenn.

A private family celebration of his life is scheduled.
