Jane C. Fehr, 101, of Willow Street, PA, died on Friday, November 30, 2018 at Willow Valley. Born in Portales, NM, she was the daughter of the late James A. and Alice Clevenger Hall. She was the loving wife of the late Paul W. Fehr and to her first husband, the late Dexter W. Cobb.

Jane moved to the Lancaster area in 1987 having lived in Media, PA for over 20 years. A graduate of Texas Women's University in Denton, Texas, she earned her Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Arts in 1937. At Northwestern University, she earned her Masters of Journalism in 1941. She received another Master's degree in Library Science from Villanova University. Her career was interesting and varied both in journalism and in the education field. Jane was Coordinator of Libraries in the Marple Newtown School District until 1974 and taught English at Upper Darby High School. An active member of St. James Episcopal Church since 1988, Jane was also a member of the P.E.O Sisterhood for 82 years, Chapter K, Lancaster more recently. Jane was also a proud docent and volunteer at the Brandywine River Museum in Chadds Ford, PA.
