Jay Frank Patton, 93, husband of the late Phyllis (Gardner) Patton, passed away on Sunday, June 26, 2022. Born in Lancaster, PA, he was the son of the late Charles P. and Naomi H. Patton.

Jay graduated from J.P. McCaskey High School class of 1946 and Ursinus College class of 1971. He served in the United States Marine Corps. during the Korean War. Jay was employed at Burroughs Corp (Unisys) for 31 years and Chester County Engineering Dept. for 8 years. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Phoenixville, PA. His Masonic affiliations were Lamberton Lodge 476, Lancaster, PA, Phoenix Lodge 75, Phoenixville, PA, Pottstown Royal Arch Chapter 198, Nativity Commandry 71 Pottstown, PA, Red Cross of Constantine, Reading, PA, and Rajah Shrine, Reading, PA. He was a Life Member of New Holland American Legion Post 662 and New Holland VFW Post 7362.
