John Longenecker, 91, died peacefully at Magnolias of Lancaster on Friday, October 6, 2023. Born in Salunga, he was the husband of the late Aileen (Werner) Longenecker, who passed away on June 28, 2021. Together they celebrated 62 years of marriage.
