Kenneth Devon Shuffelbottom, 86, of Lancaster, PA, died on Monday, April 15, 2013, at ManorCare of Lebanon, PA, where he had been a guest since 2011. Born in Lancaster, he was the son of the late Charles Henry and Miriam Fink Shuffelbottom. He was married to the late Nancy Shuffelbottom, who died in 2003.

Kenneth was a graduate of F&M Academy, Fork Union Military Academy, and Moravian College, where he received a Bachelor's degree. He served in the U.S. Navy and then joined his father at CH Shuffelbottom & Son, a real estate, insurance and construction firm that developed the Grandview Heights neighborhood. He was a past president of the Lancaster County Association of Realtors and former member of the Boards of Directors for a number of local organizations in Lancaster. He was a former member of the Hamilton Club, Lancaster Country Club, the Optimist Club, and First Presbyterian Church in Lancaster. In his leisure time, Kenneth enjoyed golf, traveling, and rooting for the Philadelphia Eagles and Flyers.
