L. Eugene Hamill, 91, of Lancaster, PA, passed away on Thursday evening, April 14, 2016 at The Mennonite Home, where he had been a guest for six years. Born in Cochranville, Chester County, PA, he was the son of the late Harry H. and Reba Randow Hamill. Eugene was the husband of the late Betty Shelley Hamill for 60 years before she passed away in 2006.

Eugene had served with the U.S. Army during World War II as a Corporal in General Patton's 4th Armored Division in the European Theatre. He was given a Purple Heart for injuries received in Germany. After returning home in December 1945, he married his high school sweetheart. He worked for the Posey Iron Works until 1957. He then was employed at Lancaster Welded Products until 1970. He returned to Posey as a production superintendent until he retired in 1983 at the age of 58.

He had been a member of Church of the Apostles, United Church of Christ in Lancaster and the American Legion Post # 56 in Lititz. He enjoyed woodworking, playing pool, bowling in Senior Bowling Leagues and was a former softball pitcher for the Southern End Church League.

Eugene will be lovingly remembered by his daughter, Beth Ann, (Clair L.) Hostetter of Lancaster, his six grandchildren, twelve great grandchildren, his sister Dorothy, (Harry) George of Lancaster, his daughter in law, Ginny Hamill

of Willow Street, and sister in law, Clauda, (Charles) Clark of Wernersville, PA. He was preceded in death by his son, Larry Eugene Hamill who passed in 2013, his sister, Helen Darrach and brothers, Donald and Harry Hamill, Jr.
