Michael J. Brogan, 42, of Lancaster died on Monday, March 12, 2018, at Lancaster General Hospital after a long struggle with lymphoma. He was the beloved husband of Meagan M. Howell-Brogan.

Michael was born in Wilmington, DE, on May 23, 1975. He was a graduate of Swarthmore College and earned his PhD in Philosophy from Villanova University.

A passionate seeker after truth, he loved philosophy, theology, teaching, the natural world, music, poetry and literature, his hometown sports teams, his friends, and his family.

His faith was unwavering and brilliant. Shortly before he died he said, 'Don't let anyone say this was unfair. I am the luckiest man alive.' He is a member of Historic St. Mary's Church and a former longtime member of St. John's Episcopal Church.

Michael taught at St. John's College in Annapolis.

Surviving in addition to his wife are his three children, Frances Jane Howell Brogan, Gabriel Kitchell Howell Brogan, and Beatrice Helen Howell Brogan; parents, Charles A. and Barbara Perry Brogan; three sisters, Meg Brown, Liz Villaflor, and Annie Brogan; mother-in-law Laura Korach Howell and seven

nieces and nephews.
