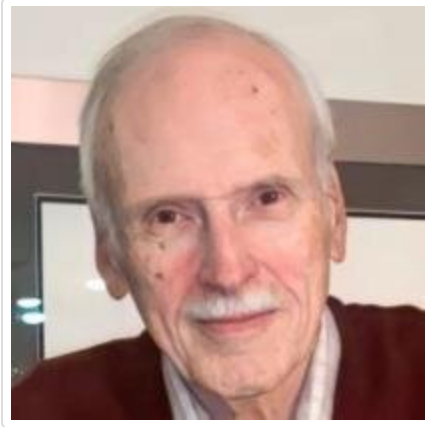




Michael Lee Rohm Sr.

Michael Lee Rohm, Sr., 85, of Lancaster entered eternal rest on Wednesday, February 19, 2025, at his home. He was born in Lancaster and was the son of the late Howard A. and Catherine M. He earned a master's degree in education from Penn State University and a master's degree in history from Temple University. He loved his career as a teacher.
