Patrick Cauler, 73, of Lancaster, died Monday, June 8, 2020 surrounded by his family at home. He was the son of the late William L. and Anna Steckler Cauler, Sr. and was married to Judith A. Brackbill Cauler for 54 years.

A 1965 graduate of Penn Manor High School, Pat worked for over 40 years in inventory control at Armstrong World Industries at the Flooring Plant.

A community-minded person, Pat was an active member at Holy Spirit Lutheran Church where he served as treasurer and on the property committee. He was a coach of the Young American Bowling Alliance, a member of the Susquehanna Sportsman Club as he was an avid hunter, playing on the church's softball league, and bowling in many leagues. 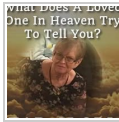

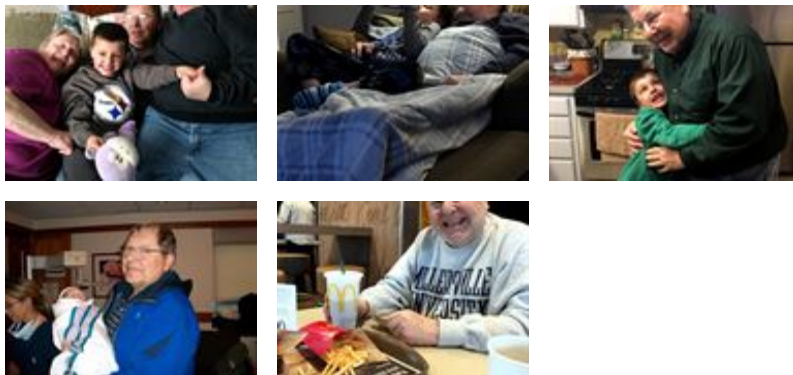
