Robert W. Johnson, 86 of Lancaster, died at his home surrounded by his family on Wednesday, April 12, 2017. Born in Lancaster, he was the son of the late William P. and Irene Walter Johnson and the husband of Marla DeWeck Johnson with whom he celebrated 58 years of marriage.

Bob graduated from Manheim Township High School and Rider University. He served in the U.S. Army from 1953 to 1955. As a livestock broker, he owned and operated Johnson Cattle Company being the 3rd generation in his family to work at the Stockyards. Later in life he found his second calling and along with his wife owned a linen and Christmas retail store on Lincoln Highway.
