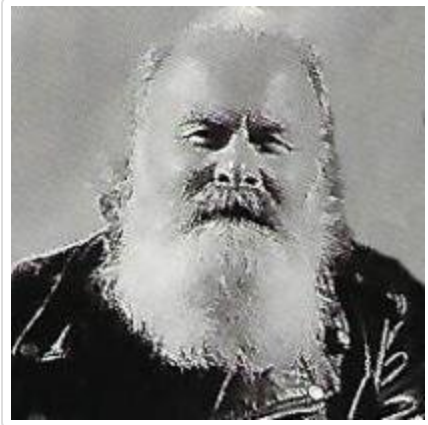




Robert W. Tangert
