Ruby M. Fring, 92, of Willow Street, PA, formerly of Yardley, Buck County, PA, passed away on Tuesday, June 7, 2016 at Lakeside, Willow Valley Retirement Community, Willow Street, PA, where she had resided since 2004.

Born in St. Paul, MN, she was the daughter of the late Oscar and Mildred Brown Nickisch and wife of the late Charles C. Fring, who passed away Sept. 25, 2009.
