Ruth B. Korman of Mountville, PA was 90 years young at the time of her death on Saturday, February 17, 2018. She was born in 1927, the daughter of Samuel H. and Ada Wonder Brown of Cambria County, PA and later the stepdaughter of Charlotte Wilson Brown.

In 1949, Ruth earned a BSN from the University of Pittsburgh School of Nursing. During her career in Pittsburgh, she met her husband-to-be, William (Bill) R. Korman, D.D.S. They moved to Lancaster County and established a dental practice in Columbia.

Ruth and Bill shared almost 52 years of working, traveling, laughing, and loving before he answered the same higher calling in 2007.

Ruth is survived by her brother, Robert Brown (of Johnstown); children: Amy, William, and Jane (Grice); and the most important people in her life, her many grandchildren and step-grandchildren.

Ruth always had a kind word for everyone, a positive outlook, and a wonderful sense of humor, often lost on those who took things much too seriously.
