William J. Schebler, Sr., 75, of Lancaster, PA, passed away on Tuesday, January 31, 2023. Born in Brooklyn, NY, he was the son of the late William J. and Phyllis M. (Rueb) Schebler. He was married to his wife, the late Rosemary E. Schebler, for over 40 years.

William graduated from Southampton Senior High School in 1965. He proudly served his country in the United States Navy from 1966 to 1969.
